Can precision technology pay?

- Soil Profiling / improving soil
 - Organic matter
 - Compaction
- Decreased inputs & waste
- Managing variability
 - Fertilizer, also seed & sprays
 - Proper placement and timing
- Yield measurements
- Data and feedback

ROBOTICS & AUTOMATION

Autonomous farm implements

- DOT (large unit, interchangeable implements)
 - Fertilizer / lime cart
 - Planting, spraying
 - Initial mapping using an ATV
- RoamIO (smaller unit on tracks)
 - Soil scanning and testing
 - Seeding clover/hay in early spring
 - Cover crops
- Data and feedback

ROBOTICS & AUTOMATION

Automatic/Voluntary milking systems

- Initial training period for the cows
- Electronic tags / transponders
- Free up labour
- Improve quality of life for farmer and animals
- Collect valuable data and information
 - Individual cow milk production
 - Milk quality
 - Cow activity

INTERNET ACCESS

Towns have broadband & great cell coverage

- In the country:
 - Cell service fades
 - Wired or wireless internet options are limited
- Telematics produced by farm equipment & robotics
 - Have to be stored & pushed to the 'cloud'
- Network controlled automation / 5G
- Security systems / video
- Online technical advice and repairs
